4. As soon as your enrolment form and deposit have reached the Cambridge Academy, we will **immediately** send you your certificate of enrolment for your course, **or return the deposit, less the registration fee, if the course is not available.**
5. When you have been admitted to a course, the £200/€300 deposit is non-returnable, but is deducted from your course fees.

- 2 weeks or more before the booked period of study begins: fees refunded (except £200/€300 deposit).
- Less than 2 weeks before the booked period of study begins: 50% refund.
- No refund can be made for late arrival, early departure, or missing part of a booked period of study.

Insurance Cover

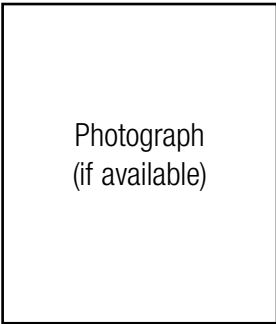
